

## **PURPOSE**

Local expenditures are included in McChord's total economic influence. All dollar figures are rounded to the nearest dollar. This information is current as of 30 September 2016.

# **PRIMARY WEAPON SYSTEM**

The C-17 Globemaster III is the newest, most flexible cargo aircraft to enter the airlift force. The C-17 is capable of rapid strategic delivery of troops and all types of cargo to main operating bases or directly to forward bases in the deployment area. The aircraft is also capable of performing tactical airdrop missions when required. The inherent flexibility and performance of the C-17 force improves the ability of the total airlift system to fulfill the worldwide air mobility requirements of the United States. The C-17 has an unlimited flying range due to its ability to in-flight refuel. The aircraft travels at speeds up to approximately 575 miles per hour and has a cargo capacity of 85 tons. Currently, the 62d Airlift Wing has 48 assigned.
