#### **JBLM Automated Installation Entry (AIE)**

Over the next few weeks you'll notice new security measures at JBLM gates. The new AIE program incorporates ID card scanners and a swing arm to control access and limit potential human errors at these checkpoints.

Cardholders arriving at the gate will swipe their ID card at the scanner, which will validate credentials against federal and base records. Guards will crosscheck photos and license plates, and the system will grant access to validated users. If you reported to JBLM prior to 1 Nov 13 you're already registered; otherwise you need to go to a Visitor's Center to enroll in the new system. During the transition period, guards will be present to provide assistance, and info is available by contacting JBLM Visitor Centers, or on the web at:
