February 2016 Monthly Military Justice Update

The following military justice actions occurred during February 2016 on Joint Base Lewis-McChord:

Courts-Martial:

- A Team McChord AMN was found guilty of making a false official statement, failure to go, and failure to obey a lawful order. He was sentenced to 15 days confinement, 15 days hard labor without confinement, and forfeitures of \$1,000 for a month.

Non-Judicial Punishment (Article 15s):

- A Team McChord TSgt was found guilty of missing a movement, drunk and disorderly conduct, and communicating a threat. The individual received a reduction to E-5 and a reprimand.

- A Team McChord SSgt was found guilty of wrongfully advising another Airman to sign a false official record. The individual received a suspended reduction to E-4, forfeitures of \$750 pay for 2 months, and a reprimand.

- A Team McChord SrA was found guilty of drunk and disorderly conduct and resisting apprehension by civilian authorities. The individual received a reduction to E-3 with a suspended reduction to E-2 and suspended forfeitures of \$878.25 pay for 1 month. He was subsequently found guilty of failure to go. The suspended forfeitures of \$878.25 was vacated.

- A Team McChord A1C was found guilty of misuse of a government travel card. The individual received 15 days extra duty and a reprimand.

- A Team McChord A1C was found guilty of underage drinking. The individual received a reduction to E-2, 30 days extra duty, and a reprimand.

- A Team McChord AMN was found guilty of underage drinking. The individual received a reduction to E-1 and a reprimand.

Administrative Discharges:

- A Team McChord SrA was discharged for Drug Abuse. The individual received an Under Honorable Conditions (General) service characterization.
