MAJOR BRIAN J. FITZPATRICK

Major Fitzpatrick is the Commander, 62d Comptroller Squadron, 62d Airlift Wing, Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington. He commands a 35-person comptroller squadron managing a budget of over \$170 million annually. As commander, Major Fitzpatrick directs critical comptroller activities in support of global combat airlift including financial budget planning, execution, cost analysis, financial services, and worldwide deployment of all finance-related capabilities. He is the chief financial officer to the wing command and provides financial management support for a combined military and civilian workforce of over 15,275 personnel, including the 62d Airlift Wing, 446th Airlift Wing, tenants, and geographically separated units. Additionally, Major Fitzpatrick has administrative command of the 21 Wing Staff Agencies comprised of over 170 personnel.

Maj. Fitzpatrick has served in a variety of financial management and acquisition positions at the Wing, Center, and Air Staff levels. He received his commission through the Air Force ROTC program at the California State University at Sacramento in 2009 and graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Philosophy. In 2016 he graduated from the Air Force Institute of Technology as a Distinguished Graduate with a Master of Science Degree in Cost Estimating and a Master of Science in Logistics and Supply Chain Management. Furthermore, Maj. Fitzpatrick is a Graduate Fellow with the National Defense University's Center for Countering Weapons of Mass Destruction. Prior to his current assignment, Maj. Fitzpatrick served as the Chief of Cost Analysis at the Air Force Rapid Capabilities Office, Office of the Administrative Assistant to the Secretary of the Air Force, Washington, D.C.
