

# AIR MOBILITY COMMAND JOINT BASE LEWIS-MCCHORD (JBLM) PET TRAVEL INFORMATION

We understand that traveling with pets can be very stressful. Here at the Joint Base Lewis-McChord (JBLM) Passenger Terminal, we want to make your experience as stress free as possible. AMC passengers with pets landing at SEATAC IAP who are flying out of JBLM will need to proceed to door #4 in the Arrivals Terminal where they will be greeted by an AMC passenger operations representative. For passengers with large pets that will be loaded in the cargo hold, the 0800 bus departure from SEATAC to JBLM will be accompanied by a van to service this need. For passengers with in-cabin pets, they are treated as carry-on luggage.

All pets will be processed in accordance with [AMC's Pet Travel Guidance](#), [IATA - Traveler's Pet Corner Guidance](#), and the U.S. Department of Agriculture [USDA Pet Travel Guidance](#). All passengers are highly encouraged to understand the requirements of traveling with a pet and to contact their local travel office or AMC terminal for questions.

For additional information to include health certificates, kennel requirements, and fees, passengers flying with pets are also recommended to read AMC's [pet travel brochure](#).

Documentation: all pets traveling to Japan must be microchipped, fully vaccinated for rabies, possess a rabies antibody test (FAVN), and possess a USDA health certificate within 10 days of boarding. All passengers must bring their pet's documentation or risk possible administrative hold or the pet being subjected to host nation quarantine at the owner's expense.
