#### National, State and Base Update:

- President Trump extended national social-distancing guidelines to 30 April.
- Governor Inslee instigate "stay home, stay healthy" extended through 4 May.
- WA State schools out thru the end of school-year.
- Per SECDEF guidance: effective immediately, anyone on DoD property will wear a cloth face mask when social distancing is not possible or practical.
  - Wg/CC guidance: Airmen who cannot social distance due to job requirements will obtain a cloth mask prior to performing their job or task

#### PCS, TDY, and Leave Travel:

- The first GO/SES in the chain of command can approve Emergency Leave/TDY of Airmen and Civilians
- All PCS travel is postponed until May 24th, exceptions for extreme hardship
- All TDY travel is postponed until May 24<sup>th</sup>, some formal training exempt and AFTRANS missions exempt
- Stay at home! Local leave travel limit (100 miles from JBLM) will resume after Stay at Home order is lifted
- Stop Movement includes Global Force Management activities; TRANSCOM forces exempt

#### Increased Health Protection Condition (HPCON) Measures:

- JBLM is under to HPCON-C with some D measures
- Pharmacy Options: McChord Clinic or Madigan drive thru, Express Scripts, Network. Refill: 968-2999, Questions 968-2586
- Pediatric well child visits – delayed or over phone, vaccinations still done for 2 mo – 1 year old. 968-3066 #4
- McChord Clinic remains open, Madigan is rescheduling elective procedures. Madigan moved to a no visitor policy
- DFACs and food services are "to go" only

#### Facility and Service Closures or Reduction:

- JBLM instigated the 9-Gage Access Plan. McChord Main Gate and Barnes Gate remain open, Woodbrook Housing is closed
- McChord ID Card/DEERS office can only serve AD, Guard, and Reserve. All others to go to Waller Hall for these services
- Commissaries and Exchanges remain Open with limits on the number of people inside, M/W/F 18-2000 at Commissary for at-risk populations. Commissary requires shoppers to wear protective face coverings.
- Winder Clinic is now the designated COVID screening clinic, McChord Dental Clinic will close tomorrow and services for Cat 3 & 4 issues will be consolidated at Dental Clinic 3: <https://www.mamc.health.mil/dental/clinics/dental-clinic-3.aspx>
- Hawk Transition Center: All classes are suspended/counselors conducting telephonic counseling only
- SFL/TAP New Enrollment Call 1-800-325-4712 or visit sf-tap.army.mil to request virtual access.
- Child Development Centers (CDCs) continue to have reduced services for mission essential personnel only
- Gymnasiums remain closed until further notice
