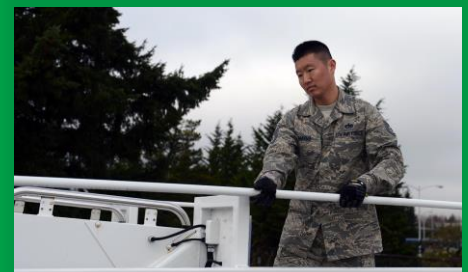

BAH Dependent Revalidation

In order to ensure fiscal accountability and audit preparation, the Air Force will be requiring all Airmen to provide documentation of dependents to their servicing finance office. This one-time recertification must be completed Air Force-wide by 31 Dec 2014. Be on the lookout for notification from your finance office—once notified, you'll have 30 days to provide the required documents to avoid disruption of benefits.
