As you've heard me say many times, each and every one of you are a critical part of Team McChord and it's up to all of us to look out for one another. As the warm weather returns to the Pacific Northwest, many of us are eager to get outside and enjoy the sun. For some Airmen, that means dusting off their motorcycles and going for a ride. Last year, there were **16 motorcycle fatalities** in the Air Force, 5 of those occurring in AMC. The top three causes of motorcycle mishaps are excessive speed, lack of experience, and distracted riders. Like participants in any high-risk activity, Airmen who ride motorcycles must exercise good Operational Risk Management and follow the guidance in AFI 91-202 & AFI 91-207. That means informing your leadership, attending the required safety courses, and wearing your protective equipment. These rules apply 24/7, both on and off base. To sign up for a course, contact your unit's motorcycle safety representative.
