A recent change to Washington state law has legalized the limited use of recreational marijuana. However, despite the changes to state law, the use and possession of marijuana remains a federal and military offense. The Department of Defense has a **zero tolerance** policy toward drug use, including all forms of marijuana. Whether you are on or off base, with civilian or military friends, or in one of the states that has legalized its use, you are subject to federal law. Joint Base Lewis-McChord is a federal institution, and the possession of marijuana by any person on base is prohibited, whether they are military members, DoD employees, or civilians. As Airmen, we are not simply required to abide by federal law, our Core Values of *Integrity First, Service Before Self, and Excellence in All We Do* demand even higher standards. Don't sacrifice your integrity or your career...remember the *Core Values* and why we serve. Let's continue to set the standard as Airmen and make our Air Force and our nation proud!
