


If you don't already have an account you will need to create one.



> Fill out all required blocks. Ensure you are selecting your proper unit information for accountability purposes.




- > After you register and are logged onto the main page ensure you have the proper base selected.
- ➤ Next select any Wingman Day class you would like to attend. You need to register for one two classes, one 0930 and one 1100 class.




Once you have selected your class, check the availability. If there are available seats click the date to register for the class. If there are no seats available select another class to attend.
