

October 2014 Monthly Military Justice Update

The following military justice actions occurred during September and October 2014 on Joint Base Lewis-McChord:

Courts-Martial:

- A Team McChord SSgt was found not guilty of sexual assault.
- A Team McChord A1C was found guilty of wrongful use of marijuana. He was sentenced to 20 days of hard labor, reduction to E-1, and a reprimand.
- A Team McChord A1C was found guilty of wrongful use of methamphetamines. He was sentenced to 15 days of hard labor, reduction to E-2, and a reprimand.

Non-Judicial Punishments (Article 15s):

- A Team McChord SrA was found to have been AWOL for a period of three days or less. The individual received a suspended reduction to E-3, a reprimand, and forfeiture of \$75 for two months.
- A Team McChord SrA was found to have made a false official statement, been drunk on duty, and failed to go. The individual received a reduction to E-3, 14 days of extra duty, a reprimand, and suspended forfeiture of \$300 for two months.
- A Team McChord SrA was found to have wrongfully used and imported steroids. The SrA received a suspended reduction to E-3, 12 days extra duty, a reprimand, and forfeiture of \$1,017 for two months, \$814 of which was suspended.

- A Team McChord SSgt was found to have wrongfully used oxycodone. The SSgt received a reduction to E-4, a reprimand, and suspended forfeiture of \$1,213.

- A Team McChord SSgt was found to have committed willful dereliction of duty by wrongfully accepting loans. The SSgt received a reduction to E-4, suspended extra duty of 14 days, and a reprimand.

Discharges:

- A Team McChord SrA received an Under Honorable Conditions (General) service discharge characterization for minor disciplinary infractions.

- A Team McChord SrA received an Under Honorable Conditions (General) service discharge characterization for drug abuse, specifically use of marijuana.

- A Team McChord A1C received an Honorable service discharge characterization for a two-time CDC failure.

- A Team McChord SrA received an Honorable service discharge characterization for fitness failures.

- A Team McChord SrA received an Under Other Than Honorable Conditions service discharge characterization for drug abuse, specifically wrongful use of steroids.
