

January 2015 Monthly Military Justice Update

The following military justice actions occurred during January 2015 on Joint Base Lewis-McChord:

Courts-Martial:

- A Team McChord Staff Sgt. was found guilty of use and distribution of a controlled substance, specifically steroids. The individual received 75 days of confinement, 45 days of hard labor without confinement, forfeiture of \$500 pay per month for 3 months, and reduction to E-2.

Non-Judicial Punishment (Article 15s):

- A Team McChord Airman 1st Class was found guilty of falsely altering the date of birth on his military identification card and of possessing alcohol under the age of 21. The individual received a reduction to E-2 and a reprimand.

- A Team McChord Staff Sgt. was found guilty of operating a vehicle while drunk and of unauthorized use of his government travel card. The individual received a reduction to E-4 and a reprimand.

- A Team McChord Airman 1st Class was found guilty of being absent without leave. The individual's previously suspended Article 15 punishment (forfeitures of \$959.00) was vacated.

Discharges:

- A Team McChord 1st Lt. was discharged for Failure to Meet Minimum Fitness Standards. The individual received an Honorable service discharge characterization.
