

## **April 2015 Monthly Military Justice Update**

The following military justice actions occurred during April 2015 on Joint Base Lewis-McChord:

### **Courts-Martial:**

-A Team McChord SrA was found guilty of wrongful use of controlled substances, specifically cocaine, MDA, MDMA, and LSD. Additionally, the SrA was found guilty of making a false official statement to AFOSI, and obstruction of justice for asking witnesses to lie to investigators. The individual was sentenced to 7 months of confinement, reduction to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

### **Non-Judicial Punishment (Article 15s):**

-A Team McChord SrA was found guilty of driving drunk and being drunk on duty. The individual received 14 days of extra duty, a reduction to E-3, and a reprimand.

-A Team McChord SrA was found guilty of willful and neglectful dereliction of duty, by escorting an individual banned from the installation onto McChord Field and having an unauthorized individual live in their dorm room. Additionally, the SrA was found guilty of making a false official statement. The individual received 15 days of extra duty, a suspended reduction to E-3, suspended forfeitures of \$969.00 for one month, and a reprimand.

-A Team McChord SSgt was found guilty of marijuana use. The individual received a reduction to E-4 and a reprimand.

-A Team McChord SrA was found guilty of marijuana use. The individual received a reduction to E-3, forfeitures of \$1,027.65 for one month, and a reprimand.

-A Team McChord SrA was found guilty of marijuana use. The individual received a reduction to E-3 and a reprimand.

-A Team McChord SrA was found guilty of marijuana use. The individual received a reduction to E-3, suspended forfeitures of \$969.00 for two months, and a reprimand.

### **Discharges:**

-A Team McChord SSgt was discharged for CDC Failure. The individual received an Honorable service discharge characterization.
