

July 2015 Monthly Military Justice Update

Courts Martial:

361st Recruiting Squadron

- A MSgt was found guilty of wrongfully using hydrocodone and wrongfully offering it to another Airman. The individual received a reduction to E-6, forfeitures of \$2,448 per month for six months, and confinement of 45 days.

Non-Judicial Punishment (Article 15s):

62d Airlift Wing

- An Amn was found guilty of falling asleep while on duty. The individual received suspended forfeitures of \$867.00 pay per month for two months and a reprimand.

627th Civil Engineer Squadron

- A TSgt was found guilty of failing to pay all of their undisputed charges on their GTC by the due date. The individual received a reprimand.

627th Logistics Readiness Squadron

- A SrA was found guilty of making inappropriate sexual remarks to three individuals. The individual received a reduction to E-3 and a reprimand.

62d Aircraft Maintenance Squadron

- A SSgt was found guilty of driving drunk and for making unauthorized cash withdrawals with a GTC. The individual received a reduction to E-4, suspended forfeitures of \$1225 for two months, and a reprimand.

Discharges:

62d Maintenance Squadron

- An A1C was discharged for minor disciplinary infractions, including conduct resulting in two LOCs, four LORs, and one Article 15 since November 2013. The individual received a General service discharge characterization.

5th Air Support Operations Squadron

- A SrA was discharged for drug abuse, specifically wrongfully using marijuana. The individual received a General service discharge characterization.

62d Aircraft Maintenance Squadron

- A SrA was discharged for drug abuse, specifically wrongfully using and distributing Testosterone, a Schedule III controlled substance. The individual received a General service discharge characterization.

62d Aerial Port Squadron

- An A1C was discharged for failing ADAPT. The individual received a General service discharge characterization.

627th Logistics Readiness Squadron

- An A1C was discharged for minor disciplinary infractions, including conduct resulting in four LORs and two Article 15s. The individual received a General service discharge characterization.

627th Communications Squadron

- An AB was discharged for drug abuse, specifically selling hydrocodone and oxycodone. The individual received an Under Other Than Honorable service discharge characterization.
