

December 2015 Monthly Military Justice Update

The following military justice actions occurred during December 2015 on Joint Base Lewis-McChord:

Courts-Martial:

- A Team McChord SrA was found guilty of one charge and one specification of sexual assault of a child. The individual was sentenced to a dishonorable discharge, two years confinement, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.

Non-Judicial Punishment (Article 15s):

- A Team McChord SrA was found guilty of failure to go. The individual received a suspended reduction to E-3 and a reprimand.

- A Team McChord SrA was found guilty of wrongful use of marijuana. The individual received a reduction to E-2 and a reprimand.

- A Team McChord A1C was found guilty of assault on a law enforcement official, bringing discredit upon the armed forces, and drunk and disorderly. The individual received a reduction to E-2 and a reprimand.

- A Team McChord A1C was found guilty of underage drinking. The individual received a reduction to E-2 and a reprimand.

- A Team McChord AB was found guilty of larceny of non-military property valued at \$500 or less. The individual received 45 days extra duty, forfeiture of \$773 for two months, and a reprimand.

Discharges:

- A Team McChord SrA was discharged for drug abuse. The individual received an Under Honorable Conditions (General) service characterization.

- A Team McChord AB was discharged for drug abuse. The individual received an Under Honorable Conditions (General) service characterization.
